

Authorization of Agent and Surrender of Copyright for Co-authored Work

1. In consideration of the publication of the Article entitled

(and referred to as the Article hereinafter), in the Co-authored Work “Handbook of Moduli” (referred to as the Work hereinafter), to be published by the Higher Education Press in China and by the International Press in the United States (jointly referred to as the Press hereinafter) , the Author

(referred to as the Author hereinafter) assigns to Ian Morrison or his successors all right in the Article for whatsoever kind of nature, including those now or hereafter protected by the Copyright Laws of the United States and all foreign countries, as well as any renewal, extension, or reversion of copyright, now or hereinafter provided, in any country.

2. The Author warrants that his contribution is an original work and that he has the full power to make this grant, and that the Article contains no matter libelous or otherwise unlawful or which invades the right to privacy or infringes any proprietary right.

3. The Author warrants that the Article has not been previously published and that if portions have been previously published permission has been obtained for publication in the Work, and the Author will submit a copy of the permission release and copy for credit lines with his manuscript.

4. The Author will receive no royalty or other monetary compensation for the assignment set forth in this Agreement.

5. The author further agrees to entrust Ian Morrison as his or her Agent for the publication of the Article in the Work and agrees that:

a. The Agent has the right to fully represent all co-authors of the Work to negotiate with the Press and sign publication contracts as well as any supplements and modifications to such contracts.

b. The Agent has the right to manage with the Press such revisions of the Work as may be needed.

c. The Agent has the right to decide the form and sequence of signatures of editors, authors and translators of the Work.

d. The Agent has the right to collect the whole compensation in free copies of the Work from the Press and to allocate these copies to the Authors.

e. The Agent has the right to fully represent all co-authors of the Work to solve disputes with the Press.

f. If the Agent needs to be changed or his authority terminated, the Author will issue a new Authorization of Agent and Surrender of Copyright for Co-authored Work to the Press.
